Symphony OCR (SOCR) VS Scanner/Desktop Software

Symphony OCR automatically detects image-only PDF files and converts them to a searchable format while preserving all original file data. Using Symphony OCR, ALL your documents are searchable based on content *automatically*.

- Symphony OCR runs on its own server, so it never uses up a local computer's processing power.
- It converts large documents and batches of documents without tying up desktop software.
- It runs autonomously in the background, so it doesn't need explicit instruction to OCR documents

- Scanner software will only convert documents that are scanned in.
- Symphony OCR constantly searches all files coming in and going out of your document management or filing system.
- It will analyze and convert all documents, prioritizing new files you add to your system
